Cycruise Pass is a card you can get discount when you go on board with your bicycle. No issuing fee is charged.

How to use.

- Just ask PASS issuing office for "Setouchi Cycruise PASS".
- Ask the office to stipulate the starting date of use.
- Validity is for 3 days. You can get the discount for the designated routes and can get valuable service at mobile phone shops.
- Do not forget to show your PASS when you go on board.

Please note that the payment method differs in each route.
 Please inquire the route operators about the detailed discount amount.

Cycling manner

- Bicycles should **keep left**. Please go in single file.
- When you are allowed to go through sidewalks, **go with reduced speed giving priority to pedestrians**.
- Please follow traffic lights and traffic signs.
- Please **hook turn at crossings**. If there is no bicycle crossing zone in pedestrian crossings, please walk while pushing your bicycle.
- **Drunken driving is absolutely prohibited**.
- **Refrain from distracted driving** such as listening music with earphones, manipulating smartphone, putting up an umbrella.
- **Always put on your helmet** for your safety.
- **Turn the lights on** in the dusk to let others notice. (Also in the tunnels) To make the following bicycles notice, put **red tail light or reflector**.
- Narrow roads are common in islands. **Reduce your speed** to avoid crossing collisions.

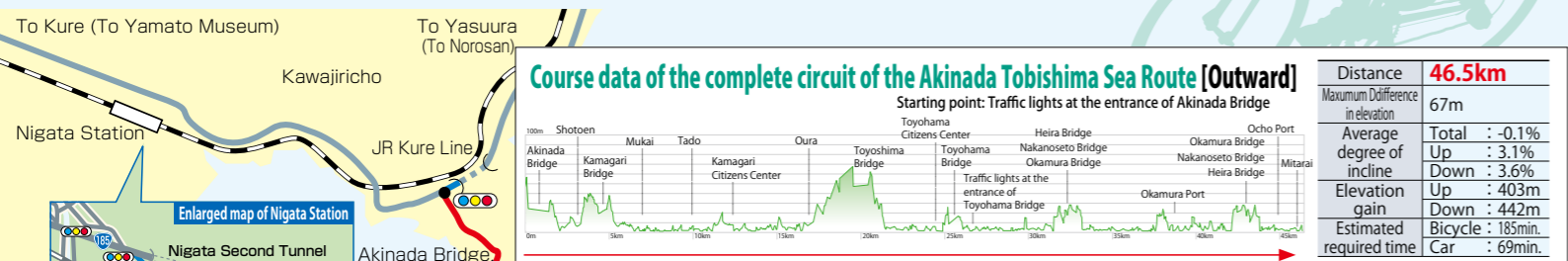

The cycling course on the Akinada Tobishima Sea Route has few ups and downs and less traffic, allowing even beginners to fully enjoy cycling. There is only one traffic light (Mitoshiro, Shimokamagari Island). Refresh yourself by cycling at your own pace viewing beautiful islands and feeling comforting sea breeze in Setouchi.

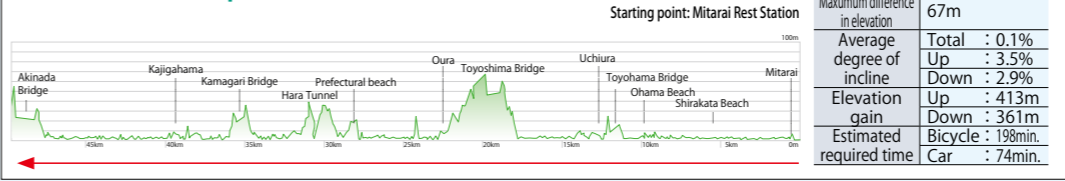
